The balustrade

The Constitution of the Supreme Council precises that at least 4 degrees shall be delivered in long form: the 14th, Perfect Elu, the 18th, Knight of Rose-Croix, the 30th, Knight Kadosh and the 32nd, Sublime Prince of the Royal secret. The 4th degree, Secret Master, is only suggested.

The 4th degree however in my humble opinion is of major importance.

First, it represents passing from the square to the compass, from the square to the circle, that is to say from terrestrial to esoteric significances.

Second, it introduces the Kabalah, and the Sephiroth, which are very important tool for reflection.

I think that one of the most important symbol of this degree is the Key of the Mysteries, which is supposed to open the gate in the balustrade in the East, this gate which gives you access to the Holy of the Holies, the Arch of the Covenant, the Tables of the Law.



The Venerable Master tell you: "I invest you with this key of ivory, the jewel of this Degree. The key unlocks the entrance of the shrine

in the East, but as yet you stand merely at its threshold and are not prepared to pass through."

The balustrade represents all the obstacles you have to overcome before reaching your final goal, in the 32nd degree, when the Venerable Master tells you: "My Brother, you will recall that in the Fourth Degree, the Candidate was presented with this key and was told that it would, at some future time, admit him through this balustrade, or gate, which barred his way. That time has now come."

You are then admitted to pass through the balustrade and you are welcomed by a representation of the Great Architect of the Universe.

It is important to note that he is the Venerable Master of the Lodge of Perfection, the same who gave you the key in the 4th degree, who attests the progress you have made during all your journey.

Note. The word "balustrade" comes from the latin *balaustrum*, the pomegranate flower. That reminds me something.
