The thirtieth degree



Although this degree, the last of chivalric degrees, is basically related to Templars, their dramatic end, and the revenge, it makes a great lap backward in the times with the appearance of two special roles in the second apartment, the Hierophant and the Sacrificer.

The Hierophant comes from one of the oldest initiatic society, the Eleusinian mysteries in Delphi in Greece. The Hierophant was in charge of receiving the candidates and explaining the mysteries. He is in fact the expert.

That brings us back to ancient Greece and the Eleusinian mysteries which are many times referred to in Moral and Dogmas from Albert Pike.

But these personages bring us also back to the Celtic and Roman civilization in which the oak, symbol of power, and the mistletoe, symbol of immortality, carry high significance.
