The twenty first degree, Noachite, or Prussian Knight

The dramatic ritual, a favorite in Bangkok, illustrates very well the motto of the degree "*A free and independent Judiciary is indispensable to Human Progress*".

However, how can we find in the same degree reference to Noah and Prussia, which differs widely in terms of period and geography?



Anderson in his Constitution mentions clearly Noah and his descent, the Noachides, as the First Freemasons. And as Humans and Masons, we also belong to this family.

It is clearly explained in our rituals that if such reference existed in the old days of the Rite, Albert Pike considered that Noah has nothing to do with chivalric degrees, and replaced him by the story of a Teutonic judicial institution. Nevertheless, we can find the direct connection with Prussian Knight in the last of the Seven Laws that Noah edicted to rule the whole mankind: prohibition of idolatry, prohibition of murder, prohibition of theft, prohibition of sexual

immorality, prohibition of blasphemy, prohibition of eating flesh taken from an animal while it is still alive and, final, **the requirement of maintaining courts to provide legal recourse.**

In addition, there are some indirect references to the Noachides in the degree: the password Phaleg, the architect of the Babel Tower, the silver full moon which reigned at the creation of Babylon by Nimrod (grand-son of Noah) and which presides at the meeting of the frank judges, the downward-pointing arrow as a symbol of the destruction of the tower of Babel.

At last, even without any connection with the drama, the first and mainly second¹ pledge of the degree bring us back to Noah and his descent and, as a consequence, to the first sentence of Albert Pike for this *degree* "You are especially charged in this Degree to be modest and humble, and not vain-glorious nor filled with self-conceit".

With or without direct reference to him, Noah remains an important figure of our tradition, as the origin through his sons of all civilizations.
