Master Craftsman Program

Allow us to re-insist on this Program of the Supreme Council.

The Master Craftsman Program is an exciting new by-mail correspondence course based upon quizzes and essays, designed and administered by staff at the House of the Temple in Washington, DC under the guidance

and leadership of the Supreme Council, 33 of the A. and A. Scottish Rite Southern Jurisdiction.

The Program includes 3 steps:

- Scottish Rite History and Ritual, based upon the degrees performed and explained in A Bridge to Light,
- Symbolic Lodge, Based upon Esoterika, a work of Albert Pike
- Scottish Rite philosophy, based upon the major work of Albert Pike, Morals and Dogma.

The Program can be subscribed individually on the website of Supreme Council.

It is suggested to work in group for 2 main reasons: it is more fun, and it is cheaper as one book is enough by group (for Taiwan, shipment of the book almost doubles the cost of the program).

HERMES

Who is Hermes, a favorite of Albert Pike?

The God Hermes, or Toth for the Egyptians, or Mercury for the Romans is the reference for the philosophy of alchemy and freemasonry.

In the old Cooke Manuscript (circa 1400) it is said the all ante-diluvian wisdom has been written on two pillars, which after the Great Flood were discovered, one by Pythagoras, the geometrician, the other by Hermes the philosopher.

*And after this flood many
years, as the chronicle telleth,
these 2 pillars were found,
and as the Pilicronicon saith, that
a great clerk that [was] called Pythagoras
found that one, and Hermes, the
philosopher, found that other, and
they taught forth the sciences that
they found therein written*

If Geometry is the operative basis of the Freemasonry, the philosophical teachings are deeply indebted to Hermes, "the father of wisdom".

Hermes the God is often confused or combined with Hermes Trismegistus, Hermes Thrice Great, who was an Egyptian philosopher author of forty two books, unfortunately all destroyed in the fire of Alexandria library.



This Hermes Trismegistus, although the reality of his existence is questionable, was claimed by the alchemists as the founder of their art, which is called the Hermetic Science, and which is referred in [Freemasonry](#), as Hermetic Rites and Hermetic Degrees.

The major works left by Hermes Trismegistus are the *Table of Emerald* and *The Divine Pyramander*. *Poemander*, the second book of the *Divine Pyramander*, offers a vision of how the divine wisdom has been revealed to Hermes and further spread to humanity, which concludes:

*Holy is God, the Father of all things.
 Holy is God, whose will is performed and accomplished by his own powers.
 Holy is God, that determineth to be known, and is known by his own, or those that are his.
 Holy art thou, that by thy Word has established all things.
 Holy art thou, of whom all Nature is the Image.
 Holy art thou, whom Nature hath not formed.
 Holy art thou, that art stronger than all power.
 Holy art thou, that art stronger than all excellency.
 Holy art thou, that art better than all praise.
 Accept these reasonable sacrifices from a pure soul, and a heart that stretched out unto thee.
 O unspeakable, unutterable, to be praised with silence!*

There are 46 references to Hermes in the Morals and Dogma, and he appears in 21st, 24th, 25th, 28th, 31st and 32nd degrees.
