Trivia from my heart

"Space -the final frontier", all star trek fans would sure know of this phrase and I am a diehard fan of Star Trek and no wonder it has struck me so hard. I did believe that space was the final frontier for all future but little did I realise that space is not just outside. Providence thought it best to reveal to me the most obvious which I have with most certainty been missing earlier. That the final frontier is not near the horizon or beyond the spheres of earths coverings but also inside me. That a Microcosm of what I was looking for outside is within me as a part of me. Or should I say I am a part of it.

As a person who walks the PATH and an adept in masonry I was exposed to various experiences in the craft which practically pushed me from being an extrovert to an Introvert in spiritual matters. The experiences through experiments carried out by me, on me, in me, in these matters have changed me to an extent that sometimes I myself don't recognise myself in terms of what I was some time ago. As long as I was a serious religious person, I was sure of everything and had an answer to most of the questions one would pose but the moment I was pushed inside or the journey started inward, I would certainly say that I have in some sense

become muddle headed. I am now not so sure of anything which I earlier was so sure of. I am unable to deny anything as untrue as each assumes meaning from its own perspective. When on the inner journey the revelations experienced makes me really doubt if these little periods of joy for no reason, or when the long persisting question just drops or melts away is insanity or really the lucid intervals for the first time.

The difficulty I am facing right now is that I have so strongly anchored myself in the outside that I am able to travel inside only as long as the chain I have provided allows me to. Having the final frontier available I am unable to let go of the anchor I have dropped so strongly. The feeling of King Trishangu who was stuck in between two realms is what I get some times. On the contrary I also feel that the IN BETWEEN is the space where probably one has to be to really BE. Is that the Equilibrium the Masters have been pointing to. I also sometimes feel that it is as close to that of the Equilibrium advocated by the great Sakhyamuni Buddha. Friends please don't chide me for making ten diametrically opposite statements in each paragraph. I am just sharing the feelings which rush through sometimes. As I said I hope these are the true lucid intervals.

I have been long wanting to write about the final teachings of Masonry and my understanding of it but have always thus far been stopped at the threshold because of the anchor which I have dropped outside.
