The 24th degree - Prince of the Tabernacle

"Reason, Knowledge and Faith"

This degree illustrates common features of some of the world's major religion, and we approach the greater mysteries, which are reserved to the initiates.



It first presents the attributes of the initiate, the lamp of the Trismegistus, or reason illuminated by science, the mantle of Apollonius, or full and complete self-possession, which isolates the sage from blind tendencies, the staff of the patriarchs, which is the help of the secret and everlasting forces of Nature. These attributes have been presented by Eliphas Levi, a French occult author and ceremonial magician, who joined Freemasonry for a short while.

The initiate shall be armed with reason, knowledge and faith, to defend himself against the blind forces of evil and achieve harmony or equilibrium, until he attains the science and power of the Magi (from Zoroaster)

The degree insists upon the necessity of evil, as a balancing force. (*very strong reference to dualism*)

The degree starts with the reference to the 4 elements, common to ancient philosophies to explain the nature: the fire, the water, the earth and the air, strong symbols of alchemy, representing the basic elements of the life. In four journeys, the candidate is tried with these 4 elements. (note that these journeys appear in the 1st degree of AASR).

The degree then turns towards the cycle of life, resurrection and immortality of soul, illustrated by common features in ancient religions: Egyptian, Hindus, Persians, Phrygians, Phoenicians, Greeks, with a murder and a rebirth, a succession of light and darkness.

This emphasizes equilibrium of forces, a dualistic approach of the world.

To better illustrate, the candidate is at that moment featuring Osiris in his coffin, in a ritual very similar to the tragedy of the 3rd degree.

The coffin is hidden under a tamarisk (similar to the acacia), and priests try to raise him unsuccessfully with Apprentice and Fellowcraft grip, which proved unable to demonstrate the existence of soul. Only the Master's grip, symbol of faith, can raise Osiris. Faith is the conviction that soul will survive the death of the body.

The conclusion is that the soul is immortal. It is a spark of the Universal Soul, which is for a while imprisoned in a terrestrial body, with all its imperfection. Life is accordingly a struggle between the Divine will and the natural will.

The initiate has to understand the great mysteries, and not to follow the worship taught to the common people by idols or allegories. (*different levels in the religious teachings*)

The murder of Hiram is re-interpreted, the first blow to the throat, again freedom of speech, the second on the heart, seat of the affection, and the third on the head, seat of intellect and reason.

To summarize, this degree offers a synthesis of the religious creeds of humanity:

- Immortality of the soul,
- Necessity of evil,
- Spark of universal Soul in an imperfect body
